

NOTRE-DAME DE LUMIERES

Notre-Dame de Lumières, a former monastery and pilgrimage destination, lies in the middle of the Regional Park of the Luberon. A spacious ground covering 30 hectares offers you nature and all kinds of outings, rambles or cross country cycling. There is a heated swimming pool available for the guests.

Hostelry Notre-Dame de Lumières offers 50 bedrooms, all equipped with a shower, a toilet and a TV. The air conditioned restaurant offers family cooking with a Provencal flavour.

The Luberon is a beautiful region for visiting, by car, foot, bicycle or horse. The mountains and forests are beautiful.
